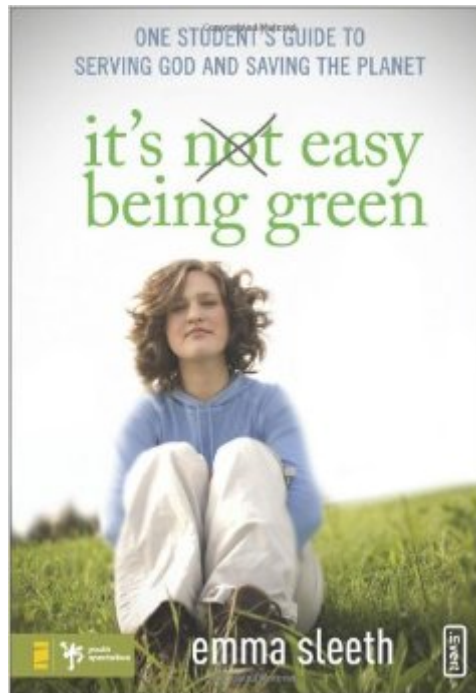

The author writes in a "cheerful and chatty" manner with lots of personal illustrations related to the various topics as presented in each chapter, but the underlying message is very serious. Many practical suggestions are given in each chapter for "doing something" to make a difference. I would recommend that church libraries any where add this book to their shelves, and that it would be good material for small group or Sunday school discussion.
