

I had hoped to send this book to a young woman I support in Africa through a Christian organization. However, the U.S.-centric references made that feel inappropriate. In addition, the portrait portrayed of a Godly woman in this book while accurate was incomplete. It sounded too much like the 1950's version of Sally Homemaker. I saw none of the strong, energetic woman portrayed in Proverbs 31 who "considers a field and buys it." Page 92 says that the highest compliment a Christian can receive is to be described as "too nice." That is not the most important message to send to young Christian women who are living in a culture where women are treated like property and their opportunities are few. They have been too nice for too long.
