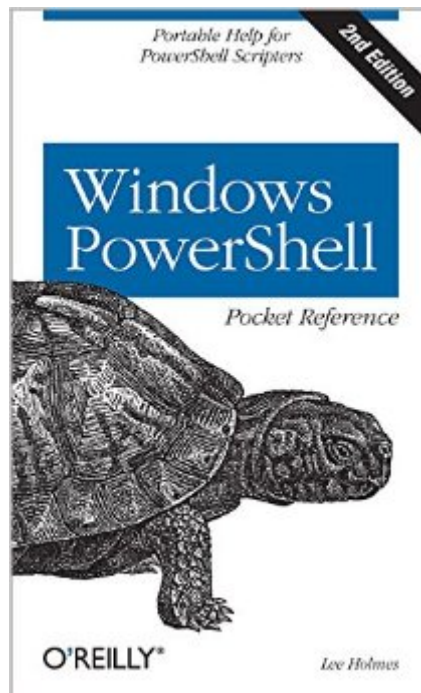

This book doesn't contain beginners learning guides or a full reference, but contains a small guide to the important functions that are required for normal administration use. Great value for money.
